A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT PRIORITIZATION LIST FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

WHEREAS, numerous requests for traffic calming projects have exceeded the City's budgeted resources to respond to and provide traffic calming solutions for all the neighborhoods currently petitioning for projects; and

WHEREAS, City staff evaluated and ranked traffic calming request using the Council-approved prioritization criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Transportation Commission reviewed the draft prioritization ranking and voted in favor to recommend Council approve the traffic calming project prioritization list for fiscal year 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, applying Council-approved prioritization criteria, staff recommends close out neighborhoods requesting traffic calming projects which scored less than 20 out of 100 as shown on Attachment 1; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the proposed action is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL approves the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Project Prioritization List for fiscal year 2024-2025; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council approves closure of the neighborhood requests for traffic calming projects that scored less than 20 based on the Traffic Calming Prioritization criteria.
