

**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ (N.C.S.)**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT PRIORITIZATION LIST FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025**

**WHEREAS**, numerous requests for traffic calming projects have exceeded the City's budgeted resources to respond to and provide traffic calming solutions for all the neighborhoods currently petitioning for projects; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff evaluated and ranked traffic calming request using the Council-approved prioritization criteria; and

**WHEREAS**, the Traffic and Transportation Commission reviewed the draft prioritization ranking and voted in favor to recommend Council approve the traffic calming project prioritization list for fiscal year 2024-2025; and

**WHEREAS**, applying Council-approved prioritization criteria, staff recommends close out neighborhoods requesting traffic calming projects which scored less than 20 out of 100 as shown on Attachment 1; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas has determined that the proposed action is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL** approves the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Project Prioritization List for fiscal year 2024-2025; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council approves closure of the neighborhood requests for traffic calming projects that scored less than 20 based on the Traffic Calming Prioritization criteria.
