## RESOLUTION NO. (N.C.S.)

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CLEAN CALIFORNIA STATE BEAUTIFICATION COOPERATIVE AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENTS WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE SALINAS-ALISAL VIBRANCY NEIGHBORHOOD BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, in October 2021, the City Council appropriated approximately \$3 million dollars in the FY 2021-2022 Capital Improvement Project (CIP 9246) Budget for immediate and short-term implementation activities of the Alisal Vibrancy Implementation Plan focused on the appearance, cleanliness and safety of the Alisal; and

**WHEREAS,** Caltrans partnered with the City to apply for the Clean California State Beautification Program which improves the aesthetics of public spaces with transformative beautification projects along the state highway system; and

**WHEREAS,** in the Spring 2022, the Alisal Vibrancy Neighborhood Beautification Project was awarded \$1,870,000 to beautify three blighted undercrossing structures (underpasses) and the adjacent fencing and roadside landscape that are gateways to the Alisal; and

**WHEREAS**, while a local match is not required, due to the continuing backlog in the supply chain, the increase in construction material prices, Caltrans has requested that the City contribute \$100,000 to show the City's commitment to the Project's quality and completion; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with Caltrans to outline the terms and conditions for the City's contribution towards the construction of the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, a Maintenance Agreement is required between the City and Caltrans to outline the City's commitment to maintain certain Project components upon completion; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas wishes to delegate authorization to execute these agreements and any amendments thereto; and

**WHEREAS,** the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301-Existing Facilities, Class 1) because the Project proposes improvements which will take place on public facilities throughout the life of the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council approves and authorizes the following:

 the Mayor to execute a Cooperative Agreement and any amendments thereto with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) authorizing the City's contribution of \$100,000 for the Clean California State Beautification Salinas-Alisal Vibrancy Neighborhood Beautification Project along highway 101, hereinafter "Project",

- 2) the payment of \$100,000 from Capital Improvement Program (CIP) 9246, EDE Alisal Vibrancy Plan, to Caltrans towards the construction of the Project, and
- 3) the Mayor to execute a Maintenance Agreement and any amendments thereto with Caltrans for the maintenance of the Project.
