A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A TOTAL OF THREE (3) “NO PARKING TOW-AWAY, EXCEPT POLICE” PARKING DESIGNATIONS IN SUPPORT OF THE SALINAS COLLISION CENTER ALONG THE FRONTAGE OF 215 LINCOLN AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Salinas Police Department requested to reserve on-street parking along the frontage of 215 Lincoln Avenue in support of the operations at the new Salinas Collision Reporting Center (CRC); and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2019, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (5-0) to recommend to City Council the approval of establishing three (3) “No Parking Tow-Away, Except Police” parking designations between the driveways as shown on “Attachment 2: Parking Restrictions Exhibit” along the frontage of 215 Lincoln Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approved the establishment of three (3) “No Parking Tow-Away, Except Police” parking designations between the driveways along the frontage of 215 Lincoln Avenue as shown on Exhibit A, attached and herewith incorporated.
