A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECT PURCHASE OF FIRE VEHICLES AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas Fire Department needs to replace 2 aging medium duty trucks; and

WHEREAS, the Department has reached out to two local vendors and received one quote from Salinas Valley Ford validating the estimated vehicle cost of \$100,000 with tax and fees; and

WHEREAS, necessary tools, communications equipment and outside installation services related to outfitting said fire apparatus are needed in the amount of \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council can approve this purchase pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code Section 12-27 (exception to low-bid based competition) in contracting for equipment, materials, supplies and services and pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code 12-28 (local purchasing preference); and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the vehicles, associated equipment, and services will not exceed \$170,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code section 12-27, the City Council hereby authorizes the direct purchase of two new ³/₄ ton medium duty trucks, all necessary tools, communications equipment, signage and outside installation services for a total cost not to exceed \$170,000.
