ALPR allows for real-time collection, processing, and dissemination. ALPR will help not only identify hot-listed vehicles and assist terrorist investigations, but also recognize movement patterns consistent with an individual acting within a terrorism pre-planning cycle prior to an attack.

The proposed project would create a Regional ALPR Program. Monterey County attracts millions from all over the world and is a host to several major international events; home to a major agricultural industry that feeds the nation; and has notable state thoroughfares, Highway 1 and 101. The proposed project includes the purchase of 12 cameras, licenses, initial storage and software; however, recurring fees will be covered by the cities. Cameras will be installed at major intersections and access points. Participating agencies will coordinate with each other, DOJ, and NCRC, which will allow for information sharing, alerting agencies to vehicles on hot-lists, assisting with terrorist and criminal investigations, and intelligence gathering.
