**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT
FACILITY SEDIMENT REMOVAL PROJECT CIP 9368 FOR
MAINTENANCE AND RESPONSIBILITY**

WHEREAS, the Industrial Wastewater Treatment Facility (IWTF) Sediment Removal Project CIP No. 9368 is a maintenance project for the three percolation ponds in response to the 2023 winter storms which damaged earthen berms, levees, overflow basin, and deposited a layer of sediment across the percolation ponds; and

WHEREAS, on June 25th 2024, pursuant to Resolution No. 23030, City Council awarded the IWTF Sediment Removal Project, CIP 9368 to American Process Group for the sum of \$5,988,344.00; and

WHEREAS, the IWTF Sediment Removal Project, CIP 9368 began on October 21, 2024 with an allowance of 90 working days; and

WHEREAS, the total construction cost, including change orders, was \$5,994,155.25; and

WHEREAS, a total of 10,010.45 dry tons of sediment were removed from Percolation Ponds 1-3; and

WHEREAS, substantial completion for the project was issued on January 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the work has been inspected to meet the requirements of the contract documents; and

WHEREAS, the project was completed within its allocated budget and contingency; and

WHEREAS, the project was determined to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301(c), Class I.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council accepts the Industrial Wastewater Treatment Facility Sediment Removal Project, CIP 9368 for maintenance and responsibility.
