## A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY SEDIMENT REMOVAL PROJECT CIP 9368 FOR MAINTENANCE AND RESPONSIBILITY

WHEREAS, the Industrial Wastewater Treatment Facility (IWTF) Sediment Removal Project CIP No. 9368 is a maintenance project for the three percolation ponds in response to the 2023 winter storms which damaged earthen berms, levees, overflow basin, and deposited a layer of sediment across the percolation ponds; and

WHEREAS, on June 25<sup>th</sup> 2024, pursuant to Resolution No. 23030, City Council awarded the IWTF Sediment Removal Project, CIP 9368 to American Process Group for the sum of \$5,988,344.00; and

WHEREAS, the IWTF Sediment Removal Project, CIP 9368 began on October 21, 2024 with an allowance of 90 working days; and

WHEREAS, the total construction cost, including change orders, was \$5,994,155.25; and

WHEREAS, a total of 10,010.45 dry tons of sediment were removed from Percolation Ponds 1-3; and

WHEREAS, substantial completion for the project was issued on January 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the work has been inspected to meet the requirements of the contract documents; and

WHEREAS, the project was completed within its allocated budget and contingency; and

WHEREAS, the project was determined to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301(c) Class I

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Quanty Act (CEQA) Guidennes Section 15301(c), Class 1.
