**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A CONTRACT
SERCO, INC FOR PARKING ENFORCEMENT SERVICES FOR THREE YEARS**

WHEREAS, the City has employed Serco, Inc to provide parking enforcement services since 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Parking Enforcement Program is an important function for the effective management of all aspects of Parking in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council received a report from staff on parking enforcement activities and a recommendation to extend existing services for 3 years in the amount of \$441,768 annually; and

WHEREAS, the Council received a recommendation to reinvest available revenue in expanding parking enforcement services with the addition of 2 officers at a cost of \$165,908 annually; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the proposed action is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes a 3-year contract with SERCO, INC for parking enforcement services as recommended for a total annual cost of \$607,676, said contract to include 2 one-year renewal options; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes the appropriation from program revenues for said three-year contract costs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into renewals and amendments to the contract, upon approval of the renewal or amendment by the City Attorney.
