**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE FISCAL
YEAR 2021-2022 SPECIAL CURB MARKINGS AND THE REMOVAL THREE (3)
SPECIAL CURB MARKINGS**

WHEREAS, business owners who have one or more special curb markings installed on city right-of-way have either not responded to annual renewal notices, or requested the removal for said markings to be removed pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code Section 20-74; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of September 9, 2021, the Salinas Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (6-0) to recommended to City Council to approve a resolution to update the status of the 2021-2022 special curb markings and delete special curb markings where businesses have requested the removal of existing special curb markings or did not submit the annual renewal fee to retain markings; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council approve a resolution approving the 2021-2022 special curb marking deletions as follows:
