A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE ALISAL SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT, CIP NO. 9360 FOR MAINTENANCE AND RESPONSIBILITY

WHEREAS, in efforts to improve the safety and comfort of an existing pedestrian facility, a marked midblock crosswalk on Williams Road a Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (PHB) was installed; and

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2023, City Council awarded the Alisal Safe Routes to School Project, CIP No. 9360, to FBD Vanguard Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$855,820.00; and

WHEREAS, construction was deemed substantially complete on March 3, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the contractor has completed all outstanding punch list items and the project has been deemed complete and the construction methods and materials met the project plan and specifications requirements; and

WHEREAS, the project included the installation of street trees and the plant establishment period of 180 days ended on August 2, 2025; and

WHEREAS, a total of three contract change orders were issued during the project resulting in a decrease of total cost to \$842,928.55; and

WHEREAS, the project was funded by Active Transportation Program grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the project was determined to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15301(c), Class I.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council accepts the Alisal Safe Routes to School Project, CIP No. 9360 for maintenance and responsibility.
