

RESOLUTION NO. _____ (N.C.S.)

A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING PLANS SUPPORTED BY RESIDENTS, DIRECTING STAFF TO PURSUE IMPLEMENTATION; AND APPROVING DIRECT PURCHASE OF SPEED CUSHIONS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF SAID PLANS

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the City's Traffic Calming Policy at its October 6, 2009 meeting (Resolution No. 19764) which outlined a process for consideration of traffic calming requests from the community; and

WHEREAS, the approved FY 2016-17 budget included funding for neighborhood traffic calming in CIP No. 9163; and

WHEREAS, following the process set by said policy, staff worked with residents at neighborhoods, to develop traffic calming plans and determine support for said plans; and

WHEREAS, significant savings in implementation costs would be realized if the speed cushions in said plans were to be purchased directly from the manufacturer;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALINAS that the following traffic calming plans are approved in accordance with City policy and staff is directed to pursue implementation of said plans:

1. Rosarita Drive Neighborhood Traffic Calming Plan
2. Little River Drive Neighborhood Traffic Calming Plan

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby approves the direct purchase of materials (speed cushions) from Traffic Logix in the amount of \$56,791 in support of implementation of said traffic calming plans.
