

RESOLUTION NO. _____ (N.C.S.)

A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE DESIGNATION OF “NO PARKING” RED ZONES ON WEST CURTIS STREET

WHEREAS, the City received a request to evaluate sight lines at West Curtis Street at North Second Street and North Third Street; and

WHEREAS, Staff conducted an analysis and determined additional sight lines are need at West Curtis Street at North Second Street and North Third Street are needed to make a gap acceptance decision for turning movements; and

WHEREAS, at its November 2018 meeting, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (7-0) to recommend to City Council to approve the designation of approximately 150 feet of “No Parking” red zones on West Curtis Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the designation of approximately 150 feet of “No Parking” red zones adjacent to North Second Street and North Third Street; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that City staff is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with implementation to fully effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
