

RESOLUTION NO. _____ (N.C.S.)

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A TOTAL OF APPROXIMATELY 140 FEET OF BUS STOP RED ZONES ALONG VAN BUREN AVENUE SOUTH OF RUSSELL ROAD AND VAN BUREN AVENUE NORTH OF EISENHOWER STREET

WHEREAS, On February 14, 2022 the Monterey-Salinas Transit agency adopted the Comprehensive Operational Analysis which proposes modifications to the existing network of bus routes in the City of Salinas; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey-Salinas Transit agency is now preparing to re-route segments of lines 45 and 49; and

WHEREAS, two new red zones are required for new proposed Monterey-Salinas Transit stops on Van Buren Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Public Works staff recommend that the City Council approve a Resolution establishing 140 feet of bus stop red zones along Van Buren Avenue south of Russell Road and Van Buren Avenue north of Eisenhower Street; and

WHEREAS, The Traffic and Transportation Commission unanimously (6-0) to approve a motion recommending to City Council the approval of a Resolution establishing 140 feet of bus stop red zones along Van Buren Avenue south of Russell Road and Van Buren Avenue north of Eisenhower Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1(c)) because the actions consist of operation and minor alteration of an existing City street; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby approves a Resolution establishing 140 feet of bus stop red zones along Van Buren Avenue south of Russell Road and Van Buren Avenue north of Eisenhower Street.
