




# Question 1: What City Council District do you live in?





# Question 3: Which Category Below Includes Your Age?




### Question 4: Economic Prosperity, Equity, & Diversity





### Question 5: Housing Opportunities for All





### Question 6: Healthy & Safe Community





#### Question 7: Youth are the Future





### Question 8: Livable & Sustainable Community





### Question 9: Connectivity, Access, & Mobility





# Question 10: A Community to Celebrate






