**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE A
THREE-YEAR SUBSCRIPTION TO SHOT SPOTTER FLEX**

WHEREAS, as a part of the State's annual budget, the 2016 California Legislature awarded the City of Salinas \$5.5 million; and

WHEREAS, the intent from the California Legislature was that \$1.5 million go directly toward anti-gang and violence prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Salinas Police Department has identified ShotSpotter Flex as a tool to help combat violence in the City

WHEREAS, ShotSpotter Flex helps law enforcement agencies by directing police officers to the precise location of gunfire incidents within seconds of the shots being fired by using sonic sensors placed throughout the city to identify when and where gunfire occurs; and

WHEREAS, ShotSpotter submitted a quote for a three-year subscription with a cost \$1.4 million inclusive of equipment, installations, software and training; and

WHEREAS, the cost to integrate ShotSpotter with the Monterey County Dispatch Center will be \$75,684; and

WHEREAS, the City Council can approve this purchase pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code Section 12-27 (purchases without notice, advertising or competitive bids) in contracting for equipment, materials, supplies and services ad Salinas Municipal Code section 12-28.080 (purchases without application of the local purchasing preference).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into a three-year subscription for ShotSpotter Flex.
