AN ORDINANCE RECODIFYING AND RETITLING CHAPTER 4 OF THE SALINAS CITY CODE AND REPEALING AND RETITLING CHAPTER 5 OF THE SALINAS CITY CODE

City Attorney Analysis

The proposed Ordinance recodifies the rules and regulations related to the Airport and the Airport operations. Chapter 4 will be recodified at Article 7 of Chapter 4 which will be titled "Public Property." The proposed Ordinance also repeals Chapter 5 of the Salinas City Code as the provisions of this Chapter have become outdated as a result of changes in State law. Chapter 5 will be retitled Public Peace and Morals.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF SALINAS as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4 of the Salinas City Code is hereby recodified at Article 7 of Chapter 4 and shall be titled "Airport".

SECTION 2. Chapter 4 of the Salinas City Code is hereby retitled "Public Property."

SECTION 3. Chapter 5 of the Salinas City Code is hereby repealed in its entirety and is retitled "Public Peace and Public Morals."

SECTION 4. CEQA CONSIDERATIONS. The adoption of this Ordinance is exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. It can be seen with certainty that the adoption of this Ordinance there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment. [CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).]

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases, be declared invalid.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day following its adoption. **PASSED AND ADOPTED** this day of , 2017, by the following vote:
