



FY 2017-18 Operating Budget Increases

Payroll Increases	\$ 230,450
New C&D Driver	109,000
New Diversion Worker	80,900
Debt Service Increase	143,400
All Other Increases	8,250
Total Budget Increases (3.5%)	\$ 572,000



Revenue Increases

7,500-ton increase in solid waste tonnage projection (4.4% increase)	513,150
3.6% AB939 Programs Increase	80,900
2.9% Increase to Franchise Transportation Surcharge	52,000
Other Revenue Adjustments (Net)	<u>(26,900)</u>
Total Revenue Increase (3.5%)	619,150




