RESOLUTION NO. (N.C.S.)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT FOR TECHNOLOGY, SOFTWARE, SUPPLIES AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH ENVISIONWARE, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT UP TO \$243,382

WHEREAS, radio frequency identification (RFID) technology has shown the capability in public libraries nationwide to offer greater efficiency through convenient self-service options, as well as a more effective way of managing the handling of materials and tracking inventory; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Library RFID and Self-Service Technology Systems and Software on March 31, 2017, and received six responses; and

WHEREAS, based on a review of the written proposals, oral interviews with three finalists and a review of references from similar projects, Envisionware, Inc. was identified as the preferred vendor; and

WHEREAS, Envisionware, Inc. has extensive technical and professional experience in designing hardware and software systems that result in greater library efficiency and has been proven to offer an excellent quality of customer service to public libraries,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into a three-year agreement with Envisionware, Inc. for the purchase of equipment, software, supplies and professional services. The funding source for this agreement is the City's FY 2017-2018 Capital Improvement Program Budget, CIP Project 9195 (Computers Upgrade LCSD) and the Library and Community Services Department's 2017-2018 Operating Budget.
