## A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF SALINAS AND 2NDNATURE, LLC FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A WATER QUALITY MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM PER SALINAS STORMWATER NPDES PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

**WHEREAS**, on February 26, 2016, a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for NPDES Permit compliance on-call support services, issued and advertised on the City's website, and in <u>The Salinas Californian</u>, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Salinas, California; and

**WHEREAS**, submittals were received from 14 firms, and the submittals were reviewed based on the selection criteria listed in the RFQ document; and

**WHEREAS,** the review panel comprising of two City staff selected 2NDNATURE as a top-ranked water quality monitoring firm with laboratory capabilities; and

**WHEREAS,** 2NDNATURE is a team of scientists and technicians with expertise in water quality monitoring program design and implementation, and

**WHEREAS**, a Professional Services Agreement was successfully negotiated, and secured with 2NDNATURE;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALINAS, consistent with the authority granted to the City Council pursuant to Salinas City Code Section 12-27 and Salinas City Code Section 12-28.080, the Professional Services Agreement between the City of Salinas and 2NDNATURE for services related to the implementation of a water quality monitoring and reporting program in the amount of \$178,481 is hereby approved; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor of Salinas is hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the City of Salinas, and as its act and deed, to execute the attached Agreement for Professional Services between the City of Salinas, a Charter City, and 2NDNATURE.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute extensions and/or modifications to the Agreement, as necessary.
