Background

The Park Classifications and Sports Facility Standards will provide guidance for acceptance of park land, collection of park fees, or provision of in lieu improvements and will also provide criteria for design of new public and private parks.

Discussion

A Study Session of the Library & Community Services Commission was held on February 14, 2018 and recommended the following changes:

- Inclusion of Community Gardens as an amenity in the Community Park type.
- Inclusion of Skate Parks as a Special Use Recreational Facility.
- Examination of the accessibility specifications in the document. A discussion with the consultant yielded no changes to the document in this respect.

- The preparation of the Park Classifications and Sports Facility Standards will guide the development and redevelopment of parks in support of the City Council's goals (2016-2019) of:
 - Safe, Livable Community
 - Well Planned City and Excellent Infrastructure
 - Quality of Life
