## A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL DESIGNATING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ALONG BRIDGE STREET AND LAKE STREET IN SUPPORT OF THE SALINAS POLICE DEPARTMENT HOMELESS OUTREACH TEAM STATION

**WHEREAS**, the City received a request to install red zones and signage on both sides of Bridge Street from East Lake Street to its northerly terminus for police and emergency vehicle parking; and to install 20-minute Green Zones along the frontage of properties of 19, 23 and 109 – 101 East Lake Street; and

**WHEREAS,** in support of the Police Department Homeless Outreach Team which will have a presence in the Chinatown area, Public Works recommends said red and green zones; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas has determined that implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the designation of red zones on both sides of Bridge Street from Lake Street to its northerly terminus; and the designation of 20-minute Green Zones along the frontage of properties of 19, 23 and 109 – 101 East Lake Street.
