

**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ (N.C.S.)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE REQUEST FROM RESIDENTS FROM A SECTION OF E. ACACIA STREET TO OPT OUT OF THE DISTRICT 3A RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, on December 1, 2009 the City adopted Ordinance No. 2498 and Resolution No. 19778 establishing Preferential Permit Parking Districts within the City of Salinas and establishing Residential Permit Parking District 3A, respectively; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Salinas City Code Sections 20-216 residents from a section of E Acacia Street (bounded by Carmel Avenue and Alameda Avenue) representing greater than 51% of the residences of the area signed a petition to opt out of the District 3A Residential Permit Parking Program; and

**WHEREAS**, at its July 11, 2019 meeting, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (5-0) to recommend to City Council to approve the request from residents of E Acacia Street (bounded by Carmel Avenue and Alameda Avenue) to opt out of the District 3A Residential Permit Parking Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementation and removal of parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council that:

1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. Resolution No. 19778 is hereby amended to remove the following street segments from the list of streets incorporated into District 3A.

3. All street signs along property frontages installed for the establishment of Residential Permit Parking District 3A, shall be removed.
