A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF SALINAS NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (TRAFFIC CALMING POLICY)

WHEREAS, the City is faced with concerns from residents regarding speeding and traffic volumes on neighborhood streets; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the negative impacts vehicle speeds and/or excessive traffic volumes on residential quality of life; and

WHEREAS the City desires to reduce the negative impacts of motor vehicle use, alter driver behavior, and improve conditions for non-motorized street users; and

WHEREAS, the City developed the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) to address the above traffic concerns citywide; and

WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program, attached hereto (Exhibit A), was considered by the Traffic and Transportation Commission at its November 13, 2008 meeting and said Commission unanimously recommended adopting the NTMP and establishing the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council hereby adopts the NTMP and hereby establishes the City's Traffic Calming Policy.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Council delegates authority to the City Engineer to make revisions to the program to ensure its effectiveness.
