**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING PROPOSAL FROM  
SERCO, INC. AND AUTHORIZING A TWO-YEAR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES  
AGREEMENT WITH SERCO, INC FOR PARKING ENFORCEMENT SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, on February 23, 2016, the City Council authorized a Request for Proposals for parking enforcement in the City of Salinas; and

**WHEREAS**, said Request for Proposals was conducted for parking enforcement services with staff recommending Serco, Inc.'s proposal based on costs, experience, approach and work plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parking Enforcement Program is the first step in the effective management of all aspects of Parking in the City and will assist in the maintenance of the City's parking assets; and

**WHEREAS**, an ordinance to amend Chapter 20 of the Salinas City Code extending authority for parking enforcement to a private contractor with oversight by the Public Works Department has been introduced; and

**WHEREAS**, Parking Enforcement is part of the Downtown Vibrancy Plan's implementation strategy as a first step in managing parking in downtown.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALINAS** that the City accepts Serco, Inc.'s proposal for parking enforcement services and authorizes the City Manager or Public Works Director to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Serco, Inc., for the provision of said services, to commence no sooner than the effective date of the proposed ordinance amending Chapter 20 of the Salinas City Code.
