## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECT PURCHASE OF FOUR 2015 CHEVY TAHOES AND THREE 2016 CHEVY TAHOES FROM FOLSOM CHEVROLET AS WELL AS THE REQUIRED BALLISTIC, RADIO/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT FOR EACH VEHICLE FROM DATA 911 AND KER INDUSTRIES AND EQUIPMENT INSTALLATION FROM LEHR AUTO ELECTRIC FOR A TOTAL OF \$521,783.98.

WHEREAS, the Salinas Police Department FY-16/17 Measure G Budget has funds available in Capital Improvement Programs (CIP) 9579 to purchase up to 10 additional police vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chevy Tahoe was identified as the vehicle best able to fit the needs of the department; and

**WHEREAS**, local Chevy dealers do not have a readily available inventory of Chevy Tahoes and Folsom Chevy has seven vehicles readily available; and

**WHEREAS**, Folsom Chevy is able to provide cooperative bid pricing through Ventura County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council can approve this purchase pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code Section 12-25 (purchases without notice, advertising or competitive bids) in contracting for equipment, materials, supplies and services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL that the Purchasing Officer is hereby authorized to direct purchase seven Chevy Tahoes from Folsom Chevy and related equipment from Data 911, Ker Industries and Lehr Auto Electric for a total of \$521,783.98 using funding from CIP 9579.
