**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A TASK ORDER FOR  
KIMLEY-HORN FOR THE DESIGN OF THE DOWNTOWN COMPLETE STREETS  
PROJECT PHASE I (CIP 9090)**

**WHEREAS**, on August 16, 2016, the Salinas City Council adopted Resolution Number 21021, accepting a federal Highway Safety Improvement Program(HSIP) grant in the amount of \$2.34 Million for the Downtown Complete Streets Project focusing on the West Alisal corridor from Blanco Road to Front Street, hereafter referred to as “Project”; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to use said HSIP construction funds, the Project design must be completed and approved; and

**WHEREAS**, Kimley-Horn, transportation consultants, is assisting the City in the implementation of the City’s Downtown Vibrancy Plan and has developed conceptual plans the form the basis for designing the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, Kimley-Horn has an executed Master Agreement with the City of Salinas and is on the City of Salinas list for On-Call consultants.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALINAS HEREBY** approves a Task Order for the design of the Downtown Complete Streets Project Phase 1 in the amount of \$210,900.
