WHEREAS, on August 16, 2016, the Salinas City Council adopted Resolution Number 21021, accepting a federal Highway Safety Improvement Program(HSIP) grant in the amount of \$2.34 Million for the Downtown Complete Streets Project focusing on the West Alisal corridor from Blanco Road to Front Street, hereafter referred to as "Project"; and

WHEREAS, in order to use said HSIP construction funds, the Project design must be completed and approved; and
