

**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ (N.C.S.)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING 125 FEET OF  
“NO PARKING” RED ZONES AND STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF  
BUCKHORN DRIVE AT SAGE WAY/ROCKROSE WAY; AND AT BUCKHORN  
DRIVE AND ROCKROSE STREET**

**WHEREAS**, the City received a request to evaluate corner sight distance at the intersections on Buckhorn Drive between Sanborn Road and Mesquite Drive to determine proper sightlines necessary to provide stopping sight distance; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 8, 2020, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (7-0) to recommend to City Council to approve the establishment of a 125 feet “No Parking” red zones and stop signs at the intersections of Buckhorn Drive at Sage Way/Rockrose Way; and at Buckhorn Drive at Rockrose Street to provide sufficient corner sight distance (see Attachment 2); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas has determined that implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the establishment of 125 feet of “No Parking” red zones and stop signs at the intersections of Buckhorn Drive at Sage Way/Rockrose Way; and at Buckhorn Drive at Rockrose Street to provide sufficient corner sight distance; and
