PARCEL A

- 1. North 22° 08' 26" West, 16.77 feet; thence crossing said vacated Work Street
- 2. North 75° 29' 44" East, 12.62 feet to a point on the southerly line of said vacated Work Street; thence along said southerly line
- 3. South 17° 30′ 04″ West, 19.60 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Containing an area of 105 square feet, more or less.

PARCEL B

A strip of land 15 feet wide for storm drain utility purposes, being bound on the west by a line lying 5 feet westerly of the existing storm drain pipeline and on the east by a line lying 10 feet easterly of said existing storm drain pipeline, the alignment of said pipeline being described by the following line:
