**CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION  
ACT (CRRSAA) (PUBLIC LAW 116-260) GRANT FUNDING FOR THE SALINAS  
MUNICIPAL AIRPORT**

**WHEREAS**, On December 27, 2020, the Congress of the United States of America signed into law the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act (CRRSAA) (Public Law 116-260); and

**WHEREAS**, the CRRSAA includes nearly \$2 billion in funds to be awarded as economic relief to eligible U.S. airports and eligible concessions at those airports to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Secretary of Transportation announced on February 12, 2021, the City of Salinas, Salinas Municipal Airport is eligible for CRRSA funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires the City to receive the maximum of available funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the use of the Grant Funds is limited to CRRSA eligible costs and shall not be used for any purposes not directly related to the airport; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 25, 2021, the Airport Commission recommended City Council approve the application and acceptance of the CRRSAA Grant agreement being offered by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Salinas that:

1. Submittal of the application and acceptance of CRRSAA Grant Funding for the Salinas Municipal Airport is hereby approved; and
2. The City Manager and or Designee are hereby authorized and empowered to execute on behalf of the City of Salinas all required documentation upon prior approval as to form by the City Attorney; and
3. Upon a grant offer being received from the FAA, including amendments thereto are hereby approved and accepted when received, consistent with Constitutional and local law requirements.
