A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DESIGNATION OF 45 FEET OF 20-MINUTE GREEN ZONES LOCATED AT 2034 NORTH MAIN STREET

WHEREAS, City Staff received a request from Sang Cha, the business owner of 2034 North Main Street, to install 20-minute green zone designations along his business' frontage; and

WHEREAS, the City received a request form and payment for the cost of installation of the 20-minute green zones; and

WHEREAS, the designation of parking restrictions on City street is exempt under CEQA 15301, Class 1(c) since the actions consists of operation and minor alteration of an existing City street; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2021, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (6-0) to recommend to Council to approve staff's recommendation of 45 feet of 20-Minute Green Zone designations at 2034 North Main Street to allow for a quick turnaround of parking spaces for customers to have access to businesses.
