**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING 85 FEET OF  
“NO STOPPING” RED ZONES AT THE INTERSECTION OF FRONT STREET AT  
WINHAM STREET**

**WHEREAS**, the City received a request to evaluate the intersection of Front Street and Winham Street for sight lines; and

**WHEREAS**, staff conducted an intersection sight distance analysis and is recommending approximately a total of 85 feet of “No Stopping” red zones at the intersection of Front Street and Winham Street to provide sufficient intersection sight triangles; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 13, 2021, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted (6-0) to recommend to City Council the approval of establishing a total of 85 feet of “No Stopping” red zones at the intersection of Front Street and Winham Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the establishment of 85 feet of “No Stopping” red zones at the intersection of Front Street and Winham Street; and
