RECOMMENDED MOTION:

A motion to adopt resolutions to approve the proposed FY 2021-22 Operating Budget and Capital Improvement Budgets for the City of Salinas and Successor Agency to the former Salinas Redevelopment Agency and approve the Annual Appropriations Limit.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council approve a resolution approving the proposed FY 2021-22 Operating Budget for the City of Salinas and Successor Agency to the former Salinas Redevelopment Agency, the FY 2021-22 Capital Improvement Budget for the City of Salinas, and a resolution establishing the Appropriation Limit for FY 2021-22 at \$277,483,548.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Please see the attached operating budget Transmittal Letter on PDF pages 13-26 and capital improvement budget Transmittal Letter on PDF pages 5-9. Staff initially prepared a balanced budget that included \$1,359,700 more in the Police budget from the General Fund. As an alternative, Staff took additional steps to cut \$1,359,700 from the Police budget. The \$1,359,700 was used to increase the General Fund reserve to 8% (\$600,700) and \$759,000 in sidewalks. Staff is highlighting this cut to the City Council so they may consider approving the budget with a change to reverse this cut.

The proposed budgets promote all four of the Council Goals: 1) Investment Strategies/Risk Management, 2) New Revenue, 3) Operational Efficiencies, 4) Public Safety

DEPARTMENTAL COORDINATION:
