TITLE: 20-MINUTE GREEN ZONE DESIGNATION AT 316 WILLIAMS ROAD

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

A motion to recommend to City Council the approval of 25 feet of 20-minute green zones located at 316 Williams Road.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the approval of the designation of 25 feet of 20-minute green zones located at 316 Williams Road.

BACKGROUND:

Mora Soto Emmanuel, owner of Abarrritos Market, is requesting 20-minute green zones along the frontage of his business property located at 316 Williams Road. According to Moro Soto Emmanuel, vehicles parked for extended periods along the business' frontage limits access for customers. Customers spend an average of 15 to 20 minutes per visit at his business. The requestor is aware that the proposed green zones, if approved, are not for the exclusive use of the requestor. The 20-minute parking restricted spaces are for the public's use. Enforcement is generally done on a call basis.

The proposed 20-minute parking zone is effective only from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. of any day except Sundays and holidays (Section 20-74 (4) of the Salinas Municipal Code). After 6:00 pm the green zone is available for general public parking.

Williams Road, between Grandhaven Street and Fairhaven Street, is a four-lane arterial street with a two way left turn lane. The street is approximately 66 feet wide, from curb face to curb face. Parking is generally permitted on both sides of the street. Currently, is a 20-minute green zone designations located at 323 Williams Road, directly across from the requested 20-minute green zones for 316 Williams Road (Attachment 2).

CEQA CONSIDERATION:

Designation of parking restrictions on City street is exempt under CEQA 15301, Class 1(c) since the actions consists of operation and minor alteration of an existing City street.

STRATEGIC PLAN INITIATIVE:

This action does not support a specific Council goal.

FISCAL AND SUSTAINABILITY IMPACT:

There is no impact to the General Fund. Mora Soto Emmanuel, authorized representative of 316 Williams Road, has submitted payment to fund the costs and the installation of the 20-minute green zone designation.
