A RESOLUTION APPROVIN NON-EXCLUSIVE TOW SERVICE FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS FOR POLICE TOWING FOR FY 2021-2022

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas, through its Police Department, manages a rotational tow program to support the Police Department's operations and enforcement of the law; and

WHEREAS, tow companies provide service to the Salinas Police Department pursuant to a franchise issued by the City and a Tow Service Franchise Agreement entered into between the City and the tow companies; and

WHEREAS, each tow company is required to pay a franchise fee to the City during the term of the franchise in an amount set by Resolution of the City Council pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code section 20-191; and

WHEREAS, the franchise fee is based on the number of tows generated and the City's actual costs in managing the franchise tow program and is paid quarterly by the franchised tow companies.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of Salinas that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an annual non-exclusive tow service franchise agreement with the franchise tow companies.
