**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECT PURCHASE FIVE (5)  
LIFEPAK 15 v4 MONITORS FROM STRYKER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$109,532.68**

**WHEREAS**, currently the LIFEPAK 15 v1 cardiac monitors purchases in 2009 have exceeded their serviceable lifespan: and

**WHEREAS**, the replacement of these lifesaving devices will meet the requirements of the Paramedic Provider agreement with the Monterey County EMS Agency: and

**WHEREAS**, Stryker can provide the five LIFEPAK 15 v4 cardiac monitors applying a trade in program for older unserviceable LIFEPAK 15 v4 units saving the City of Salinas \$49,585.50 for a total cost of \$109,532.68: and

**WHEREAS**, purchasing the LIFEPAK 15 v4 cardiac monitors is vital to delivery of Advance Paramedic patient care; supports a safe; livable community; provides for the health and safety of the employees; and allows for efficient emergency medical services operations maintaining interoperability for fire department operations; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for this purchase is available in the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year CIP and operational budget; and-

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has the authority to approve direct purchases of goods and services under Salinas Municipal Code Section 12-27; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the criteria of Section 12-27 are met.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council authorizes the City Manager and Finance Director to complete the purchase authorized by this Resolution and sign all necessary contracts upon review and approval of the City Attorney.
