TITLE: MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN SALINAS VALLEY SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY AND CITY OF SALINAS

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

This is a Resolution between the Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority and the City of Salinas, with a recommended motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the parties.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the attached Resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign the Memorandum of Understanding between the Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority and the City of Salinas.

BACKGROUND:

City staff has been working with the Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority to identify the parameters of both rescinding the City's Notice of Intent to Withdraw from the Joint Powers Authority and having the Authority bind itself to relocate all transfer operations from the Salinas Transfer Station to the Madison Lane Transfer Station. The attached Memorandum of Understanding works to complete this important task.
