## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FIFTY-TWO (52) DESIGNATED FOOD TRUCK LOCATIONS

**WHEREAS**, the primary purpose of the public right-of-way is for use by vehicular and pedestrian traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2007, the City Council enacted Ordinance No. 2474 to allow vending on public streets and establish a permit process for street vendors; and

**WHEREAS**, conducting business on city streets from a food truck may have negative land use, public safety, and traffic impacts which the city desires to regulate; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2020, the City Council adopted the Vision Zero Policy (Resolution No. 21790). A policy setting a goal to eliminate traffic fatalities and severe injuries on city streets while increasing safe, healthy, equitable mobility; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas has determined that implementing parking restrictions and regulations is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1); and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the City Council hereby approves the Resolution establishing fifty-two (52) designated food truck locations; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the city engineer is hereby authorized to approve changes to the designated locations, as necessary, to reduce obstructions in the right of way and improve public safety.
