A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE REQUEST FROM RESIDENTS FROM SAN MARCOS COURT TO OPT OUT OF THE DISTRICT 3A RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2009 the City adopted Ordinance No. 2498 and Resolution No. 19778 establishing Preferential Permit Parking Districts within the City of Salinas and establishing Residential Permit Parking District 3A, respectively; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Salinas City Code Sections 20-216 residents from a section of San Marcos Court greater than 51% of the residences of the area signed a petition to opt out of the District 3A Residential Permit Parking Program; and

WHEREAS, at its September 9, 2021 meeting, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (6-0) to recommend to City Council to approve the request from residents of San Marcos Court to opt out of the District 3A Residential Permit Parking Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementation and removal of parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council that Resolution No. 19778 is hereby amended to remove San Marcos Court from the list of streets incorporated into District 3A.
